Family Concessions

A sibling concession on tuition fees applies for children of the same family who are attending Southern Vales Christian College at the same time. This annual rebate is applied to the family's total bill based upon the number of siblings enrolled as follows:

Families are only eligible to receive the sibling discount once a Tuition Agreement form has been received by the College and completed to the satisfaction of the College.

School Card

School Card families will be charged Full Fees initially. Once the College is formally advised that your School Card application is successful, then the reduction will be applied to your account in July. Families who lodge late applications, after the College cut-off date will be charged the full Tuition Fee rate less any minor DECD component amounts of School Card. Please note, this means you must lodge your application, at the very latest, by the end of Week 3, Term 3. Earlier lodgment is preferable as State Government approval takes some time. Forms will be available from Week 3, Term 1. Please contact the College if you require a School Card form.

Building Fund

The College has a Building Fund to which parents may make voluntary, tax deductible contributions. It is requested that each family donates \$200 each year. The support of the Building Fund is essential for further refurbishment and development of facilities.

Payment of Fees

All fees are to be paid in the year they are charged. Fees may be paid by the following methods:

1. Annually in advance, due by the first Friday of Term 1, with a discount of 5% on tuition fees.
2. By regular direct debit or credit card installments via the Edstart payment process. Please register at edstart.com.au/svcc to begin making regular payments

The Southern Vales Christian College Board reserves the right to terminate the schooling of a student whose fees are in arrears. The College also reserves the right to charge a late payment fee and the cost of recovery fees on overdue accounts.

When a student is to be withdrawn from the school, parents are required to give the Principal one term's notice (i.e. 12 weeks), in writing, before the withdrawal date, otherwise parents will be liable for an additional term's fees.
